• 11 May

Maker: Mandy Coates

Willow: 'Bulrushes and Seed Heads with Leaves'. Learn the figure of eight and 'corn-dolly' weaving techniques to create your own garden ornaments.

• 18 May

Maker: Hannah Coates

Copper: Make a piece of jewellery of your choice and/or an ornamental decorative panel from recycled materials.

• 25 May

Maker: Andy Hazell

Tin: Turn your old biscuit tin into something less useful but far prettier using pliers, snips and a little bit of imagination – get creative with re-cycling!

• 8 June

Maker: Kate Barlow

Cotton: An introduction to crewel work embroidery. This traditional technique is at least a thousand years old, you will cover a handful of commonly used stitches, including chain stitch, French knots, stem stitch and trellis work. This workshop is perfect if you are new to hand embroidery or just a little rusty.

Maker: Kate Jordan

Fruit and Flowers: A nature inspired floral arrangement using master florist techniques.
